

Garry Kasparov



Garry Kasparov was the official World Champion of the World Chess Federation (FIDE) from 1985 to 1993. After his disengagement and removal in a dispute, he remained the holder of this title recognised by most of the chess world until 2000. In 2005, he surprisingly retired from chess. For a large part of the chess public, Kasparov is considered the strongest player in chess history. Since then, Garry Kasparov has been active as a Russian opposition activist. Among other things, he founded the opposition alliance “The Other Russia”, which, however, was not admitted to the Russian parliamentary and presidential elections...
