At just 30 years old, Benjamin Bargetzi's passions for neuroscience and artificial intelligence have made him one of Europe's most successful keynote speakers and a leading expert in the field. Originally growing up in a Swiss mountain village, his fascination for both people and machines brought him all the way to East & Southeast Asia, the United States, London, Oxford, and across Europe. He has been repeatedly ranked as a Top30 thoughtleader and a leading voice in Europe on change management strategy, business, neuroscience, and future technologies by two of Europe's largest professional agencies—Leading Minds and Premium Speakers. Globally, he ranks among the Top 0.5% of most successful keynote speakers both by impact and by booking volume. He has become internationally recognized for his unique combination of neuroscientific research with principles from the psychology of courage, business transformation, and artificial intelligence.

CAREER

Benjamin Bargetzi researched and studied neuroscience, psychology, and philosophy in Oxford, Singapore, and Zurich. Afterwards, he became more and more fascinated by the idea of artificial brains and intelligence, bringing him to the study of Al technology, robotics, and software. His professional journey led him across senior positions at both Google and Amazon in the United States and in Europe, where he oversaw a variety of multi-million dollar digital transformation projects.



Today, he is the Founder and CEO of the Bargetzi & Company Group, which operates businesses across three domains: a corporate venture builder (a machine learning service where Bargetzi and his team of engineers that come from places such as Google, Apple, ETH Zurich, and Stanford help companies transform themselves by deeply understanding client identifying needs, growth opportunities, and then implementing cutting-edge machine learning solutions to drive future success); an international venture capital investment programme for Al startups active in Asia, Europe and the USA; and the ACIT Global Future Institute, a research institute dedicated to understanding the future of technology and neuroscience, connecting over 5,000 scientists and professionals across 30+ countries.

Bargetzi thus leads a variety of transformation, business consulting, and innovation projects for institutions such as the World Economic Forum and many of the world's top-leading Fortune 500 companies. His deep understanding of neuroscience, people, technology, and business equips him to assist companies effectively in navigating the fast-paced, human-centric, technology-driven landscape of the 21st century.
